We will endeavour at every opportunity to stress to the governments of Italy and Spain, the need to make representation to the Polish government that it must respect independence of the media and allow all diversity of views to flourish.

FNSI and FAPE sends you its best wishes and assures you its members will stand shoulder to shoulder with their Polish colleagues and help in whatever way they can.
